Peace and Joy: jesus during his earthy life gofted Blessed mary to the Church, as the mother of the Church, and the Eucharist as his continued presence in the Church. The Risen Lord continues to bless the Church as we hear in the Gospel this weekend with the gift of Peace and the Holy Spirit. These gifts transformed the life of the Apostles as we see in the life of St Thomas. Thomas had put all his hope on Jesus of Nazareth. He left everything he had and followed Jesus for three yearsthroughout Galilee and judea. Thomas witnessed the Lord's miracles. He was held spellbound by Jesus' preaching. He admired the Lord's kindness and love. He had heard Jesus saying that He was establiching the Father's Kingdom. And he was certain that he, one of the chosen 12, would have an important place in that kingdom. And then Jesus was arrested, and crucified. Everything seemed lost, the hope for the future, the conquest of the Kingsom of God, the role of the disciples in the Kingdom. Thomas' mourning was so great that he simply could not believe it when he heard the other disciples say on the third day after jesus' death that they had seen the Lord. It seemed like a cruel joke, just re-opening the wounds of losing Christ. He would not believe them. In this life situation Jesues comes to Thomas. The Gospel does not record that Thomas touched Jesus, hands and side as so many paintings depict: just that jesus offered them to Thomas. What the Gospel does record is Thomas' immediate response, "My Lord and My God," and the risen Lord becomes his joy and peace. Let the Risen Lord be the joy and peace to us.
