Parish visit of the Most Reverend John Wilson, the Metropolitan Archbishop of Southwark

We extend a warm welcome to our Archbishop John Wilson to our Parish who is on his first parish visit to the Parish of Corpus Christ-St. Peter and St. Justus, Tonbridge. The Archbishop will preside over the 10 am Family Mass this weekend. After the Holy Mass the Archbishop will spend time to meet us while we all share refreshments in the Fisher Hall.

Archbishop John Wilson was born on 4 July 1968 in Sheffield. He began formation for the priesthood for the Diocese of Leeds and was ordained to the priesthood on 29th July 1995. In 2005, Archbishop John Wilson was appointed Episcopal Vicar for Evangelisation in the Diocese of Leeds and later was elected Administrator for the Diocese of Leeds. On 24th November

2015 Archbishop John was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Westminster and then on 10th June 2019, he was appointed Archbishop of Southwark by Pope Francis on the retirement of the late Archbishop Peter Smith. The great sense of shepherding his people entrusted to his spiritual and pastoral care was visible in his homily on the day of his Installation as Archbishop of Southwark. The Archbishop said, “the Pallium reminds me to exercise my ministry with the heart of the Good Shepherd. Without exception, I must care for those the Lord entrusts to me, looking out especially for the lost, the broken, and the wounded, lifting them up and carrying them home. Someone once commented that it would be ridiculous for a shepherd to leave the whole flock in search of one sheep who’s gone astray. Ridiculous, of course, unless that one sheep is you or someone you love. As bishops, priests, and deacons, we share the special responsibility for shepherding the hundred, not just the ninety-nine”. Let us this weekend welcome our Archbishop with great joy and listen to him with filial love.
