Jesus and Zacchaus: The message of the Gospel passage this week is Conversion. The word conversion (conversio-Latin) means 'to turn around' which has a corresponding Greek word 'metanoia', meaning a change of heart. Zacchaeus the chief of the tax collectors is introduced into the story because he wanted to see Jesus and find for himself who this person was. We read that Zacchaeus ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree to see Jesus. When he was at the top of the sycamore tree, Jesus asked him to come down. To answer the call of Jesus means to come down from our position as observer. We cannot be spectators but let Jesus enter the inner sanctuary of our personal life. People saw Zaccheaus as a sinner but Jesus saw in him a faith seeker who was humble and sincere of heart. A mere glance and a few words of acceptance from Jesus changed this man from the sinner the community thought him to be into a man to whom Jesus had brought salvation. The presence of Jesus had given to Zacchaeus the twin gifts of grace and justification. We must take the first step to reach out to anyone hiding from faith life because many of them have been so intimidated or discouraged that they have resigned themselves to their routine of life. When we invite them with unconditional and non-judgmental love to share our experience of faith, we are spreading the Good News of God's love in a way that touches their hearts more than any amount of preaching can do.
