Attitude of Gratitude: The central theme of this Sunday's readings is gratitude. Naaman, the Syrian military General in the first reading, was not only an outcast because of his illness; he was also a non-Israelite. But he returned to thank the Prophet Elisha for the cure, and as a sign of his gratitude, transferred his allegiance to the God of Israel. Jesus was on the border between Galilee and Samaria where He was met by a band of ten lepers, including both Jews and Samaritans who were drawn together by their common misery and who ignored their traditional enmity. As the Samaritan learned that he was healed, he returned to Jesus to thank him. Each Sunday, like the Samaritan, we return to celebrate the Eucharist in gratitude for all the gifts that God has showered upon us as individuals and as a community. In faith, we hear the words of the bible as the gift of God's Word to us; we believe that the people around us are the church; we affirm the bread and wine on the Altar as Christ, the Father's ultimate gift to us. If we count our blessings, then we shall be more likely to act like the Samaritan leper to return with joy and give God thanks and praise every Sunday. Although we may not suffer from physical leprosy, we may suffer from the 'spiritual leprosy' of sins which makes us unclean. Jesus is our Saviour who wants to heal us from this leprosy of sin. Since Jesus is not afraid to touch our deepest impurities, let us not hide them. Just as the lepers cried out to Jesus for healing, let us also ask Him to heal us from the spiritual leprosy of sins including impurity, injustice, hatred and prejudice. Fr. Saju
