Remembrance Sunday

It is good to have a season of the year for remembrance. The month of November facilitates an act of memory on 2nd of November, the Holy Souls and on 13th November Remembrance Sunday. On Holy Souls day, we recall with an act of memory those who have gone before us from this life, helping us to sense a greater and wider communion of saints to which we belong.

On Sunday 13th November we remember with thanksgiving and sorrow those who gave their lives in war, praying for them and for all who continue to suffer because of war. They left home and family in search of justice, freedom and peace; the effects of which we feel in our land today. The sacrifices of the past make moral demands of the present. This is to say that remembrance Sunday makes us vigilant, because we must never be deceived into thinking that which happened once could never happen again as we face challenges in the region of Ukraine. The Holy Mass is the celebration of the life of Jesus which he commanded us to do "in memory of me". The celebration of the Eucharist makes present to us the King of Peace. This Sunday we will offer at 10 am Mass special prayers for those who gave their lives in war and for all who continue to suffer because of war. I invite you to join with the parish community to hold a short period of silence at this Mass to mark our respect and love to all who laid down their lives for noble and just causes. **Fr Saju**
