Gaudete Sunday -The Lord is coming is the recurring theme in the season of Advent. The third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete Sunday" because today's Mass begins with the opening antiphon: "Gaudete in Domino semper", "Rejoice in the Lord always." The antiphon reminds us that we are preparing for the very joyful occasion of the birth of Jesus; and we light the rose candle. Isaiah in the first reading reassures the people of Israel who are returning from exile to Jerusalem that God will re-establish the glory of Israel. This will be a new era of joy and peace. Similarly the advent of Jesus brings forth peace and joy. Jesus said to John's disciples, 'Go back and tell John what you hear and see; the blind see again, and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised to life and the Good News is proclaimed to the poor; and happy is the man who does not lose faith in me.' Advent is a season for us to place our faith in the Lord that we may find courage and confidence to address our anxieties and worries of daily life. Fr. Saju.
