Parish Leads: The Church, as explained by the Second Vatican Council, is by her very nature missionary. The Gospel of this Sunday tells us that Jesus sent seventy committed disciples, two by two to communicate God's love, to bind up wounds, and to be peacemakers in a troubled world. Each one of us is a missionary to continue these ministries of Jesus in our time. Parish leads is the diocesan initiative focusing on forming committed laity to be missionaries by being involved actively in the areas of evangelization, formation and Catechesis in the parish. This is in accordance with the call of Pope Francis. "We can count on many lay persons, although still not nearly enough, who have a deeply-rooted sense of community and great fidelity to the tasks of charity, catechesis and the celebration of the faith. At the same time, a clear awareness of this responsibility of the laity, grounded in their baptism and confirmation, does not appear in the same way in all places. In some cases, it is because lay persons have not been given the formation needed to take on important responsibilities. In others, it is because in their particular Churches room has not been made for them to speak and to act." Pope Francis, Evangelii Gaudium, 102. The parish leads in our parish will receive input sessions and needed support from the Archdiocese so that they will be able to take a lead role in evangelization, forming our parish as a missionary parish. I request your prayers so that there will be more individuals called by God to journey together as missionaries to build up our community, reaching out to all with love of Christ. Fr Saju.
