Lazarus -The Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus that we hear this Sunday has left Bible many readers wondering why the rich man had to go to hell. We are not told that he acquired his wealth by foul means. There is no indication that the rich man was responsible for the poverty and misery of Lazarus. We do not see Lazarus begging from him and the rich man refused to help. The story does not narrate that the rich man committed any crime or evil deed. All we read is that he was fed and clothed well as any other successful human being has a right to do. The poor man Lazarus was lying at his gate and the rich man failed to reach out and share a little of his blessings with someone in need at his door step.

In his interview with Fr. Antonio Spadaro, S.J., editor in chief of *La Civiltà Cattolica*, the Pope Francis commented, "I see clearly that the thing the church needs most today is the ability to heal wounds and to warm the hearts of the faithful; it needs nearness, proximity. The Pope continued, "In fact, there is a temptation to seek God in the past or in a possible future. God is certainly in the past because we can see the footprints. And God is also in the future as a promise. But the 'concrete' God, so to speak, is today. Further the Gospel passage helps us to reflect whether we bring warmth to people around us and recognise God in them. In other words, any kind of indifference to situations around us is not approved by God and not appropriate to our Christian vocation. **Fr Saju**
