## **Called to Celebrate**

In the first reading from the prophet Isaiah we read, 'on this mountain, the Lord of hosts will prepare for all peoples a banquet of rich food. On this mountain he will remove the mourning veil covering all peoples, and the shroud enwrapping all nations, he will destroy Death for ever. The redemption of God's people is like a 'banquet of rich food, a banquet of fine wines, of food rich and juicy.' In the Gospel today Jesus described the kingdom of heaven as a wedding reception which was the most joyful time in a Jew's life. But as we read in today's Gospel, those who were called refused to come. So the King sent his servants out into the highways and byways to invite everyone they could find. They gathered all whom they found, both good and bad because many of his own people were resisting his invitation. The invitation to the people from the byways tells us that God's invitation to each one of us is purely an act of grace and not something that we deserve by our good works. This parable is a reminder of Israel's history as well. God invites Israel into a personal relationship with God but Israel continually fail to respond to this invitation. Jesus describes them as going 'one to his farm, another to his businesses'. In other words, these things of the world, though not evil in themselves, preoccupy them. They are too busy to accept the invitation because their priorities and passions are elsewhere. God invites all to God's salvation. The parable also warns us that those who reject the Gospel and its message of salvation will experience darkness in life. However, having initially answered the invitation, we cannot take things for granted and there is no room for complacency in the following of Christ but always wear the 'wedding garment' of true discipleship rather than uncommitted membership in the church.
