Parish Finance: Thank you for all your contribution and support. In July, the parish had ordinary income of £12,313 and expenses of £22,284, resulting in a reduction of resources by approximately £10,000. July income was slightly lower due to seasonality and timing of receipts, and of gift aid income. Expenses markedly higher due to repairs in St Justus, investments into connectivity equipment at St Justus and the Fisher Hall, and expenses related summer holiday cover. In addition, parishioners generously contributed £583 for apostleship of the sea (Stella Maris) and Peter Pence. Signing up to Gift Aid is simple and fast through QR code at the back our churches, for those eligible. If you are not part of the Standing Order, we welcome your contribution to offertories; SVP donations and any other collections via card machines at the back of the church and in Fisher Hall which can be made after Sunday morning Mass during the coffee morning. You can register for gift aid through the card you use to make payments.
