The Second Week of Advent

Parish Priest: Fr Saju Thomas

On this Sunday of Advent we hear the account of the ministry of John the Baptist as given by the Evangelist Mark. John proclaims the Advent of the Messiah in the wilderness. A new Exodus is proclaimed for a renewed journey. The desert for him is a symbol of the religious situation of Israel. John attracts the common people into the wilderness to hear his message of repentance so that they are purified and spiritually ready for the coming of the Messiah.

Our journey through Holy Advent is to hear the message of repentance. We cannot come under the sovereign rule of God without a change of attitude, a change of heart and a change of lifestyle. "Do small things but with great love" said Mother Teresa. There are basically two reasons why we fail to receive forgiveness. The first is that we fail to repent, and the second is that we fail to forgive. Jesus was very explicit about this second failure in Matthew 6:14-15. He says, "For if you forgive men their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions." William Barclay notes that it is only when we say, "I am a sinner" that Jesus can say, "I forgive." It demands our listening to what God is saying to us and then making changes in our life. The advent reconciliation on Tuesday 19th December will be an opportunity to celebrate our conversion into communion with Jesus. Fr. Saju
