

Advent Reconciliation Service: The Gospel reading for this weekend challenges us to be witnesses of Jesus who is the light of the world. We, through our baptism, are called to help others to prepare their lives to remember the first coming of Jesus in Bethlehem and to celebrate the advent of Christ who comes every time in the Eucharist and then for Christ's final coming. John the Baptist told his listeners that he is not the light, but the one who bears witness to the light. Further, he testified that he was the voice crying in the wilderness, to prepare them for the coming of the Lord. John proclaimed to the people a baptism of repentance by water. Like John, we are not the Light but we are called by our baptism to bear witness to the Light by all we say and do. Advent reconciliation offers us a beautiful opportunity for preparing us for Jesus Christ and to be his witnesses. I invite you to join for the Parish Advent reconciliation on Tue 19 Dec at 7.30 pm as there are a few priests available to hear confession. <u>NB</u> As the Fourth Sunday of Advent falls on Sunday 24th December there are the usual Sunday Mass times. The Christmas Eve Vigil Mass is at 6.00pm and Mass of the Night at 10.00pm, to attend these Masses is outside usual Sunday obligation. **PARISH FINANCE**: In Oct the parish had ordinary income of £17,980 and ordinary expenses of £27,929. The resulting shortfall of £13,387 is mainly explained by two large expenditures: damp proofing the Corpus Christi church and upgrading the sound system at St Justus. Taking those one-offs aside, net adjusted ordinary income was £336. Thank you for your continued generosity which the parish relies on to maintain a positive financial balance.
