Peace and Joy of Christmas 2023

PARISH FINANCE: In Oct the parish had ordinary income of £17,980 and ordinary expenses of £27,929. The resulting shortfall of £13,387 is mainly explained by two large expenditures: damp proofing the Corpus Christi church and upgrading the sound system at St Justus. Taking those one-offs aside, net adjusted ordinary income was £336. Thank you for your continued generosity which the parish relies on to maintain a positive financial balance.
