First Week of Advent - Advent marks the beginning of the Church's new liturgical year and a four-week preparation leading up to Christmas, in which the first coming of the Son of God is remembered. It also leads us to set our minds and hearts to live in a spirit of expectation, of anticipation, of preparation, of longing for the Lord. This message is visible in the Scripture readings in the first week of Advent which call upon us to be watchful and stay awake. In Advent there is a need to have a focused approach of preparation in order to celebrate the feast of Jesus Christ born among us as a human person in a stable at Bethlehem to be one with us. In Advent we reflect on our role as a disciple to stay awake by living faithfully our discipleship like the faithful and trustworthy servants who behave loyally during the absence of their master. They have their responsibilities and they know what they are supposed to do. If they are faithful, they will carry out all those tasks given to them whether the master is present or not. When the master does eventually return, the faithful servants will be in good stead because they have done what they were supposed to do. They have done their task with diligence and loyalty. Similarly Advent is a season suitable for reflection on the role of our Blessed Mother in our redemption.

During Advent let us make a conscious effort personally or in the family to prepare for Christmas by using resources available in our parish. We should try to join in praying the Rosary with the parish, taking time to be at the Adoration, or participating in Meditation, etc to meet the Lord who comes daily in the sacraments and in the Word to fill us with grace. This will help us to disconnect with our business of life and to create a space for the child Jesus and thus to create a Holy Advent season in us. Fr. Saju
