CALLED TO HOLINESS: The Gospel for this Sunday states that Jesus came not to destroy the law but to fulfil it. This statement may have surprised his audience a great deal, because Jesus was constantly accused of breaking the law and finally the accusation at his death was that he was breaking the laws continuously. People observed that he did not wash his hands prior to the meal that the law demanded, he healed people on the Sabbath day, and now he speaks of the law with veneration and reverence. Jesus tells them that not even the smallest part of the law will be changed and he is there to fulfil the law and bring it to completion. Jesus was presenting the true meaning of the law. The first example Jesus gives is about anger, as well as use of any insulting word is forbidden. If we do not respect our brothers and sisters from the depth of our heart, we cannot say we respect God. When Jesus says: 'Do not get angry with a brother or sister,' he is not condemning anger in itself. There are times when we too should be angry, angry about unjust situations. Nevertheless our anger about injustice should not give rise to a lessening of love and growing to hate. Anger becomes dangerous when it turns into hostility. Hostility causes us to act out our anger. It leads to deep resentments, negative attitudes. A Jewish saying has it: 'Anger in the heart is like a worm in a plant.' If we find ourselves often getting angry, we should look at the cause of our anger. The cause may well be within ourselves. Naturally we are not perfect, but God calls us to reflect on how we live and to understand what has gone right and wrong for us. Such reflection can lead us to insight that will help us to live better and be virtuous in the future. "As he who called you is holy, be holy yourselves in all your conduct, ¹⁶ for it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy." (1 Peter 1:15-16) Fr Saju.
