## **Blindness and Vision**

Today as we enter the fourth Sunday of Lent we are called upon to renew our faith and experience Christ as the light of our life. The Gospel of today presents to us Jesus as the light of the world from the account of the curing of a man born blind. The man born blind is given sight in an extraordinary way. There was nothing exceptional about this man. He was not important. He was poor, a blind beggar, tapping his cane along the street and begging for a bit of food. He didn't even know who Jesus was, and he didn't ask to be cured. But when his eyes were opened how readily he accepted Jesus. Jesus Christ saw a man born blind, while his disciples and the Pharisees saw a sinner from birth, who is beyond redemption. The blind man became an evangelist and took on the unbelieving, blind Pharisees, explaining how Jesus must have come from God. The man who had been blind is able by way of faith to see who cured him, in all his depth and to profess his faith in Jesus. Pope Benedict XVI once observed that the miracle of healing of the blind man is a sign that Christ wants not only to give us sight, but also open our interior vision, so that our faith may become ever deeper and we may recognise him as our only Saviour. Jesus illuminates all that is dark in life and leads men and women to live as "children of the light". Whenever we approach others with prejudices, misunderstanding and judgement etc, we display our blindness. Let our spiritual journey in Lent lead to new vision. On Mothering Sunday I wish all of you who share motherhood spiritually and physically – **Happy Mother's Day.**
