Holy Week Journey: This Sunday we celebrate Palm Sunday, or Passion Sunday. With the liturgy for Palm Sunday we enter into the final week of Jesus' life on earth. Holy Week begins with the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover, then leading on to his passion, death and resurrection. This week's liturgy focuses also on us to prepare our hearts for the agony of His Passion and the joy of His Resurrection. In the passion narrative from the Gospel of Matthew we see Peter (Matt 26:58) following the arrested Jesus 'at a distance'; and then going inside to sit down in the courtyard (Matt 26:69) with others in order to hear the conversation of the people around. Subsequently we see Peter denying Jesus three times. Like Peter, if we keep distance from Jesus, the centre of the Holy Week liturgies and then focus on mere celebrations of Easter, we may keep denying Jesus. In our journey through the Holy Week, we need to delete anything that creates distance with Jesus while we participate in the celebrations of Holy Week. Let our intention be to attend the celebrations of Holy Week with great reverence and devotion. The Lenten talks of Canon Tom McHugh on Mon, Tue and Wed this week will help us to reflect on our relationship with God, increase our Faith and strengthen our lives as disciples of Jesus. I invite you with your family and friends to participate at the Lenten talks and the Holy Week celebrations in our parish. I wish you God's blessing and a fruitful Holy Week. Fr Saju.
