# **Road to Emmaus**

The Easter accounts that we read after Easter Sunday suggest that Christ comes to the disciples in their ordinary life situations. Cleopas and an unnamed disciple, as we hear this Sunday, were on their way to Emmaus. Emmaus is a small town located seven miles northwest of Jerusalem. They were leaving Jerusalem and its disturbing events because for them, Jesus' death was an unmitigated tragedy. Now as they met a stranger on the way, they were surprised when this person expressed his ignorance of the events in Jerusalem. They told him about the crucified Jesus and how they had hoped in him. The stranger listened to their experiences. Eventually the stranger helped them to see these events through the lens of the Scriptures. In the evening of this journey, at the table fellowship, the two disciples recognised that the Stranger was Jesus. For, when Jesus took bread, blessed it, broke it and distributed it to them, their eyes were opened to recognise the Lord. The risen Lord meets us in our daily life situations. As His disciples we need to share our life situations with Jesus and then listen to him to understand our lives with the help of the Word of God. This is a personal encounter with Jesus which helps us to experience the burning of hearts in our spiritual life whenever we set aside time to journey with the Lord in prayer, meditation and reflection.

The breaking of the bread and the breaking of the Word at Holy Mass lead us to the same experience, having a new vision of faith, meeting Jesus in the Eucharist. Let us greatly desire to participate in the Holy Mass to experience the companionship of Jesus, one who walks with us and listens to our life stories and then heals them with Word and Eucharist. Fr.
