## **Sound of Silence**

The Sunday Gospel this weekend opens as "Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead to the other side while he would send the crowds away. After sending the crowds away he went up into the hills by himself to pray" (Mt 14:22-23). These verses suggest the importance of personal space and time in the life of Christ's disciples. The disciples who were busy, are guided by Jesus to spend some time by themselves. This was something necessary for them to refresh their minds and reflect upon their life journey. Time out from our business of life is helpful to enable us to think about our life and spiritual journey. This reflection, in a context of silence, will help us to experience God's presence. Encountering silence is a pathway to encounter God's presence in us. As the first reading of this Sunday says, "there followed a great wind, an earthquake, and a fire, but God was in none of them." Then there came "a sound of sheer silence, in which Elijah perceived God." (1Kgs19:11-13). It was in silence that Elijah experienced God's presence. Pope Francis encourages us to enjoy silence in life especially as part of preparing for Holy Mass. The Pope says, "I ask that we never regard prayerful silence as a form of escape and rejection of the world around us." The time before Mass is not "for small talk," he said in a Wednesday general audience, but "for recollection within the heart, to prepare ourselves for the encounter with Jesus. Silence is so important!"

On Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> August we celebrate the feast of the Assumption of our Blessed Mother. On this feast day, we honour Mary with a grateful heart for her beautiful life which collaborated with salvation. The feast affirms that Mary's earthly life was completed; she was taken up, body and soul, into heavenly glory, where the Lord exalted her as Queen of Heaven (CCC 966). St. Francis said, "We are the mother of Christ when we carry him in our heart... and we give birth to him through our holy works which ought to shine on others by our example." Wishing you a very joyful feast of the Assumption; **Fr. Saju**
