World Youth Day Experience

Eleanor who attended this year's World Youth Day (WYD) from our parish shares her experience here. I thank her for taking great effort to attend WYD and for her generosity in sharing the experience with us. This will I am sure help us, especially young people to reflect on their space and role in the church. Fr. Saju

WYD is a week-long international gathering of young adult Catholics that takes place every few years. This year it was in Lisbon, Portugal. I went with a group of around 40 pilgrims from across the Archdiocese of Southwark, and it was an incredible experience!

WYD involved several services attended by thousands. For the biggest one, led by Pope Francis, one and a half million Catholics gathered in a huge park for Eucharistic Adoration on Saturday evening, then slept out under the stars and had Mass together on Sunday morning. We also attended catechesis, learned about different vocations, attended Mass celebrated by Archbishop John (who travelled with us), and visited the shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. I met many pilgrims from other countries too. Lisbon had an exciting atmosphere, full of Christian joy, and faith of my fellow pilgrims was really inspiring too. Each year World Youth Day has a theme, and this year's was 'Mary arose and went with haste' (Luke 1:39). We felt encouraged to 'rise up' to follow God's will for our lives, despite the challenges involved. Most importantly, this pilgrimage showed me that young people really do care about faith. As Pope Francis told us, 'in the Church, there is room for everyone.'

I'm enormously grateful for all your prayers for World Youth Day and kind responses to my talk. Do check out the photos of the pilgrimage on the parish and Archdiocese Facebook pages! I pray that others in this parish get involved in World Youth Days in the future, perhaps joining the Archdiocese pilgrim group or volunteering at WYD. The next one is in Seoul, South Korea in 2027!
