# **Church – Home of forgiveness**

The Scripture readings for this Sunday share the message that the authority comes from God and the exercise of authority is an expression of faithfulness to God. Isaiah through the first reading (Isa 22:19-23) tells us how God removed the proud 'master of the royal palace' from his office, taking from Shebna the power and responsibility of which he had proven unworthy, and gave both to the humble and faithful Eliakim. In today's Gospel we read how Jesus entrusted the Church to Peter and the Apostles. This took place at Caesarea Philippi, (presently called Banias), twenty-five miles northeast of the Sea of Galilee (Mtt 16:13-20). Jesus asked a question in two parts about his identity; 'who do people say I am'? When the people identified Jesus with Elijah and with Jeremiah, they were paying him a great compliment and setting him in a high place, for Jeremiah and Elijah were the expected forerunners of the Anointed One of God. In the second part of the question to the Apostles, 'who do you say I am', Peter responded, 'you are the Christ, the Son of the living God'. Peter was the first apostle to recognize Jesus publicly as the Anointed One, thereby Peter became the first disciple to receive a personal blessing. "Blessed are you, Simon son of John!". Moreover Peter is called the rock on which the church is built and he is entrusted with the keys of the kingdom of heaven with the authority to bind and loose on earth. The Keys to the Kingdom are the words of forgiveness granted by God in the Church to bind and loose on earth which has validity in heaven. The Church is founded on forgiveness, the Church is the home of forgiveness. Fr Saju
