The Gift of the Lord

The theme for our prayerful reflection this weekend is forgiveness. Through the parable of the unforgiving servant, Jesus teaches us to forgive others. God revealed himself in Jesus and revealed His closeness to us and desire to forgive us. Jesus is our model in forgiveness. In the Gospel account for this Sunday we read that a servant whose own debt of ten thousand talents was cancelled by his master, was unable to forgive his fellow servant for the hundred *denarii* owed to him. This is an indication that there is something fundamentally wrong in his approach though he had received forgiveness from his master. His failing is a radical absence of forgiveness' or refusal to forgive. Anyone who refuses to forgive will lock himself into a torturous circle, thereby keeping away from the very experience of forgiveness.

Forgiveness is that remarkable reality of God's incredible mercy for us shared through Jesus, and in rending forgiveness, our hearts are moved in God's love. Forgiving does mean letting go of resentments, bitterness, hatefulness, desires for revenge, and the need to lash out at someone for what he or she did or did not do. Forgiveness implies learning to love those who have harmed us and understanding the struggles that may have contributed to their harmful behaviour. Forgiving can even mean being happy for the health and welfare of those who have hurt us and praying for their continued wellbeing. Ultimately, forgiveness is freeing oneself with God's love and any crushing weight is removed when we share this gift from God. It is important to understand that forgiveness does not obligate us to put ourselves or others at unreasonable risk or to set the sinner up for another fall, but it is a call to share the gift of forgiveness that the Lord offers us in everyday life.
