St Vincent de Paul Awareness Month: As September is St. Vincent de Paul awareness month, we would like to give a brief background of the beginnings of the Society. Inspired by the works of St Vincent de Paul, Blessed Frederic Ozanam, at the age of 20 in 1833, together with a group of students set up a charity 'not of discussion but for action'. It was Father Peter Murphy, who initiated the formation of the Corpus Christi Branch in June 2016. Its purpose is to reach out to the lonely, homebound and people who may need material or spiritual assistance of any kind. Our members help in transporting parishioners to weekday and/or Sunday mass. Members also take Holy Communion to homebound as well as visit lonely Parishioners.

In 2019, as a project for Advent, we asked Parishioners to donate non perishable goods to be distributed to the needy through the food bank at Paddock Wood. The Parish has been very generous and we are continuing the outreach by collecting and donating regular amounts of non-perishable food and baby items to St Margaret Clitherow Primary school where a great need has been highlighted especially due to the present economic crises. We would like to thank parishioners for their ongoing generous donations. We would also like to take this opportunity to ask anyone, who would be interested, to join us in continuing this valuable work in our Parish (Trevor, SVP).
