Justice and Mercy

The Parable of the vineyard-workers (Matthew 20:1-16) for this weekend illustrates the theme of justice and mercy. The men who had worked all day received a day's wages, one denarius which is their due and this is justice. But they believed that the men who had worked less hours than they had, who came in the third hour, would receive less, particularly those who had worked only one hour. But those who worked one hour also received the same amount. Those who arrived first became envious and complained, 'you have treated them the same as us.' In our terms justice is about merit, but generosity is about need. God shows justice to our need. St Thérèse of Lisieux has rightly said, "God's justice is his mercy."
