## **Meaning of listening**

On the 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the liturgical year, the Scripture readings invite us to focus on the word 'listen'. Prophet Ezekiel in the first reading says that those who listen to God and then turn away from their wickedness by doing what is lawful and right, they will be saved. Further, the prophet reminds the people of Israel that their failure to do God's will, caused suffering, slavery and subsequent deportation to Egypt, Persia, and Babylon. The parable of the two sons in this weekend's Gospel, helps us to distinguish the attitude of the Pharisees and the Scribes from those of the prostitutes and tax collectors. Looking at the two sons, one will find that both failed their father in one way or the other. The first son represents all who were not following the way of Christ; Matthew the tax collector or the woman caught in adultery were living a life not listening to God's will. However they responded to the invitation of Jesus to conversion and then communion with the Lord. The second son represents the Pharisees and the Scribes. These Jewish leaders and their ancestors had a long tradition of following God's law to the letter. However they refused to accept John the Baptist's 'pattern of true righteousness' of doing God's will and to listen to the teachings of Jesus which disturbed their way of life. The second son may represent some of us who during the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Orders and Matrimony, boldly before God and humanity as witnesses, responded "I will" to every question posed to us, but do not fulfil them. The parable reminds us of how people can change their minds, or their way of life, for good or for evil. Let our prayer with the Psalmist be, "show me your ways, Lord, teach me your paths. Guide me in your truth and teach me". Fr. Saju
