Follow me...:

The Readings for the weekend invites our reflection on our promptness in responding to God's calling. We have received God's calling to follow Jesus Christ. This Saturday, the families who celebrated baptism in 2023 gathered to celebrate their promises to be the first and best teachers of faith to their children which they accepted at the baptism of their child. It reminded them that Baptism which incorporates us to the body of Christ, the Church, is God's calling to follow Christ. This is further affirmed this weekend when the *confirmandi* for this year will celebrate the Rite of Enrolment at the vigil Mass, expressing their promptness in celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation. These are graceful moments for the parish to accompany our young people in their explicit responses to follow Christ. Jesus in today's Gospel passage invites a few individuals to follow him. Jesus takes the initiative and this is the action of grace in our life; and it does not depend on anything we do, but God's gift to us. Secondly Jesus chooses individuals from among the ordinary people. In this case they were fishermen, an occupation which involved hard work and a certain amount of knowledge and skill. The explicit invitation of Jesus is to share in the life and works of Jesus by leaving our former way of life immediately and without hesitation as we read today, 'at once they left their nets and followed him.' We are called as we are in our given situation and we should follow him with promptness. Fr. Saju
