THE DEVOTION TO THE HOLY FACE OF JESUS

This beautiful devotion was revealed by Jesus to Sister Mary of Saint Peter, a Carmelite nun in Tours, in the 19th century. The primary purpose of the devotion is to make reparation for sins against the First Three Commandments: Denial of God, blasphemy and the profanation of Sundays. Jesus urged this Work of Reparation to be spread to every town and lamented any that did not, such is the power of this devotion against evil. A second nun, Blessed Maria Pierina de Michelli, of the Daughters of the Immaculate Conception, in the 20th century to whom Jesus appeared, asked for Devotion to His Holy Face in reparation for the insults He suffered in His Passion and for the sacrileges committed against the Holy Eucharist. Our Lady gave her an Image of His Majestic Face with the Holy Eucharist on the reverse, medals were made and approved. Pope Pius XII received the first medal and in 1958 declared the Feast of the Holy Face of Jesus for all Roman Catholics on Shrove Tuesday, in accordance with Jesus' desire, this is preceded by a Novena.
