God's forgiveness

The Final session on the Our Father will be on Monday 11 March 2024 in the Fisher Hall. I thank all those who attended the sessions to reflect and nourish their Lenten journey. It was encouraging to see the openness of the participants to share their experiences and reflection with their group. You will see below extracts from Shyla, who was very generous in sharing her experience of this journey with the parish. Fr. Saju

This lent as a parish we have been reflecting on *Our Father*. Last Monday we were asked to prayerfully reflect on the part of the Our Father where we say "give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." One of the questions that was asked during the reflection was, what have you heard today that you find challenging? I knew my answer right away, "forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." It struck me, "if I don't forgive others, then will I be forgiven by God?" Certainly this was a 'soul searcher'. I become conscious that 'no big deal' sins are a big deal to God; sins separate me from Him and others. In the Gospel of Matthew 12: 24-30 the parable of the weeds, v 25b says, "the enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat and went away." I can see that my life being filled with weeds, these so called 'no big deal' sins. "Let both grow together until the harvest, and at harvest time I will tell the reapers, gather the weeds first and bind them in bundles to be burned, but gather the wheat into my barn." God is a Righteous judge who reaches out to us with love. That's what I see in the prayer Our Father. Reflection on the Our Father during Lent is a beautiful opportunity to experience God as Abha, dad who forgives us unconditionally.
