HOLY WEEK

With our Palm Sunday celebration this weekend, we begin our journey through Holy Week which is special to us. The period of Lent for our parish offered opportunities to prepare us as one family for Holy Week. We initiated this journey in Lent with sessions on *Our Father* on the first four Mondays of Lent, identifying this prayer as the model prayer of the Church, and helping us to grow in personal and communal prayer. The first part of *Our Father* as we explored focuses on praising and thanking God, then leading one to pray with faith and trust in God for present, past and future situations in life. Similarly the first three days in the fifth week of Lent, we were fortunate to have Mgr. M. Dickens, Canon V. Darlington and Canon B. Coyle to lead us to Holy Week with their Lent talks. Mgr. Dickens took us along with the Emmaus Journey (Luke 24) asking us to become aware that Jesus walks along side each one of us calling, 'come with me, move with me and change with me', thus offering us constant opportunities for conversion to communion with the Lord. Canon Darlington explained the journey of the Samaritan Woman (John 4) with Jesus, the seventh man in her life, offering her conversion to communion with the Lord. She became an apostle to proclaim Jesus as Messiah. Canon Coyle reflected that communion with the Lord helps us to encounter Christ as a gift to life. I am very grateful to all those who participated in these sessions and talks. I pray that these preparations now will help us to experience the Holy Week liturgies and to share the joy for resurrection- the Lord is Risen. *Fr Saju*
