Make a joyful noise unto the Lord! (Psalm 100)

Corpus Christi choir are introducing singing the psalm on a regular basis and invite everyone to join the response. The Responsorial Psalm is one of the key things to sing at Mass, fostering meditation on the word of God and the Psalms are, in a way, the original hymn book! The Psalms offer beautifully poetic prayers for every circumstance of our human existence and relationship with God: joy, praise, love, suffering, repentance The Responsorial Psalm links with the other readings, the Gospel and the liturgical season. Many familiar hymns are based on Psalms – All people that on earth do dwell, O God you search me, Bless the Lord my soul, Eagles wings and, of course, The Lord's my shepherd to name a few. Many other hymns are based on scripture. Vatican II calls the people of God to 'full, active and conscious participation' in the liturgy, and singing at Mass, beautifully led by the choir, is a wonderful way to unite in love and thanksgiving to God. Like the psalm, all music at Mass is a prayer, so what comes from the heart is more important than perfection, and the character different from music heard in the everyday world, giving a sense of wonder and awe at Christ's holy presence among us in his living word and the Eucharist. We are blessed to have a parish which fills our churches with the praise and glory of God each week. (Parish Choir)
