THE FIVE FIRST SATURDAYS DEVOTION — "I promise to assist all those who practice the devotion of the first Saturdays on five consecutive months with the graces necessary for salvation at the hour of their death." *Our Lady of Fatima to Sister Lucia, 10<sup>th</sup> December 1925.* Our Lady told the little shepherds of Fatima, Ven.Lucia, St.Francisco and St.Jacinta, that "God wishes to establish in the world, devotion to my Immaculate Heart." During these five months we say the rosary, with the addition of the prayers that the Angel of Peace taught the children. The other requirements are to receive Holy Communion and to go to Confession (pref within 8 days) and to spend 15 minutes meditating or more of the Mysteries of the Holy Rosary. The rosary is said every Saturday at 9.30am before Mass, the Holy Face Devotion follows after Mass. The Five First Saturdays make reparation for wounds against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the Holy Face Devotion makes reparation to the Holy Face of Jesus for blasphemies which wound His Sacred Heart. We started this devotion of the Five First Saturdays in May as a group at Corpus Christi, but one may start at any time. The intention is to encourage us to respond to Our Lady's request at Fatima.
