Dear Parishioners I celebrated my first Mass in Corpus Christi on Thursday, and the Gospel really has given me insight into how to face this new role. In the Gospel (Jn. 15:9-11), Jesus teaches his disciples that love is the hallmark and criterion of Christians in his Last Supper discourse. He told the disciples the importance of loving others as He has loved them and bearing the fruits of the Holy Spirit in their lives. This Sunday's Gospel (Jn. 15:9-17) is from the same chapter but six verses more. This is not a mere coincidence. The Holy Spirit is trying to reach out to us twice this week at this time of transition and change. The Holy Spirit knows how we, as human beings, are affected by the change. My prayer is that we acknowledge and give ourselves permission to connect to whatever feelings we are experiencing currently because of the change and be able to offer it to God at the Holy Mass and allow the Holy Spirit to gently touch our hearts and slowly heal whatever we need healing. Depending on our history, we respond to change in many ways. Generally, our human response to change is resistance. Rightly so, because change brings uncertainty and fear of the unknown, which can trigger anxiety and stress; as Humans, when we are not in control of the situation, it can leave us powerless. This powerlessness can be a space where grace can come into our lives. I am walking this path of transition with all of you. I am adapting to a new space, a new building, new people, a new church, and a different way of working. You are also finding ways to build a relationship with me. We are all navigating this transition together and I hope that we can learn to trust the process and allow the Holy Spirit to lead us. Let us unite in prayer, asking the Blessed Mother to comfort us with her mantle of peace. If we welcome change with love, what will it look like? Fr. Take
