This Sunday's Gospel reminds us that Jesus is always with us in the boat of our life. It can sometimes be physical storms, emotional storms and spiritual storms. We should not forget that Jesus is just resting in our life's boat and is ready to help. Our faith in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist will give peace, and He will still the storms.
