Peter, whose original name was Simon or Cephas, was a professional fisherman and was introduced to Jesus by his brother Andrew, who chose to leave everything and follow Christ. Paul's name was originally Saul, a Roman citizen and a pharisee. Paul used to persecute Christians but was converted to Christianity after a vision and became the most important and influential among the saints. May we all be encouraged and inspired by their journey of faith. Like them, we must open our eyes and ears so we can hear and experience the presence of our Lord in our everyday life and, most of all, when we receive His body and Blood in the Holy sacrifice of the Mass.

Carlo is a modern-day young person, soon to be canonised, who decided to pray the Rosary and attend Mass every day. Like Peter and Paul, Carlo has chosen to follow Christ
