SOME GENTLE REMINDERS ABOUT RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

One may receive Holy Communion in two ways - either directly on the tongue or, if preferred, in the hand, in which case please cup your left hand firmly in order to receive the Consecrated Host and place your right hand underneath to form a secure receptacle. When you have received the Consecrated Host, please place it respectfully straight into your mouth, using your right hand fingers, before moving away from the Priest or Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist.

May we also remind you that the practice of Intinction (ie dipping the Consecrated Host into the Chalice) is not recommended by the Bishops of England and Wales and, therefore, is not a practice that has been adopted in our Catholic Churches, bless.
