As Peter, James and John saw Jesus' divinity revealed, their attitudes to Jesus must have been transformed just as they saw Jesus was transformed. We could say that is what Lent is all about, transforming ourselves and our attitudes so that we can see Jesus more clearly. During this season of Lent we examine our lives to see where we stand before God and each other. The Collect for Mass today expresses beautifully our hopes for Lent to our heavenly Father, be pleased, we pray, to nourish us inwardly by your word, that, with spiritual sight made pure, we may rejoice to behold your glory. On behalf of all, I prayed that our hearts would be open, that we be freed from darkness, and have our sight restored. It is really a prayer that we be transformed during Lent. I think we can see this call to transformation also in the Scripture readings we heard proclaimed today. In the first reading, Abram is promised the land by God (Gen 15:18). But when we move to the New Covenant, we see that there is no emphasis at all on land. There is a new vision with the arrival of Jesus and all previous values have to be re-evaluated. Many times in the Gospel of Matthew Jesus said, "You have heard it said...but I say to you..." (Matt 5) Instead of inheriting land, in the New Testament the emphasis is on the kingdom of God. In the New Covenant, the land to be inherited is heaven (Heb 11:16). Just as the Hebrews were enslaved in Egypt and crossed the sea during the exodus to freedom, we were in sin and crossed the sea when we were baptized. The Hebrews wandered for forty years in the desert and then entered the Promised Land; we live here and then look forward to meeting God. So much of what happened in the Old Covenant is now seen as a sign or symbol to teach us about the spiritual life and our journey to God (see 1 Cor 10:6). Fighting for the land of Israel is something we see in the Old Testament. We have moved on now from thinking about a geographical territory and in the New Covenant the land to be concerned about is inheriting heaven (Heb 11:16). Lent is a time to see with new eyes.
