Gospel reflection. Jesus never condemned people for their sin. For example, you may recall the story of the woman caught in adultery. When she was brought before Him, He did not condemn her, but told her to go and sin no more. He also said to the people "Let the one among you who is guiltless be the first to throw a stone at her... You judge by human standards; I judge no one", John (8:7, 15). Yes. Through parables and stories Jesus taught his listeners a moral or spiritual lesson.

In this parable the orchard is the world. The owner is God. Each tree in this orchard represents a Christian believer or a community. The gardener is of course Jesus - the owner's servant and son. A barren tree is a believer whose life has been unproductive despite knowing about Jesus and taking all the nutrients from Him but giving nothing back in return. Some expositors refer the three years the owner gave to the tree to bear fruit to the three years of Jesus' public ministry during which He called people to repent and believe in His gospel. Some scholars point to God's successive calls to Israel by the Law, the prophets and Christ. Some others say that the number three represents completeness - so a period of full opportunity is given to the tree to become fruitful and productive. In other words, God's purpose is to ensure that every tree in the orchard becomes fruitful. **Fr Philip**
