## Gospel Reflection.

We think of Jesus as the Son of God and Messiah. But yet if you met him and no one had pointed him out to you, you wouldn't know he was Jesus. Twice in our Gospel today John the Baptist says, "I did not know him myself." (John 1:31,33) John said, "he who sent me to baptize with water had said to me, 'The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and rest is the one who is going to baptize with the Holy Spirit.'" The descent of the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove on Jesus was the signal for John. The Pharisees were listening to John speaking and they did not recognize Jesus as the Messiah, so John said to them, "Look there is the lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world." The Father pointed Jesus out to John, and now John pointed Jesus out to the Pharisees. Because Jesus was so normal you would not pick him out from the crowd. *Fr Philip*
