- 1) Pick a time Count the birds for one hour in your garden, local park or from your balcony between 24 and 26 January 2025.
- 2) Tell us what you see Only include those that land, not those flying over. Count the most birds of a particular species you see at any one time. So, if you see a group of eight starlings together, but later see six together, please write down eight as your final count.
- 3) Submit your results before the 23rd February 2025. Online is the best way to do it, as it's quick, easy and saves us money, so we can spend more on saving nature.

Go to the website at <u>rspb.org.uk/birdwatch</u>. Remember even if you saw nothing, it still counts. Enjoy your moment with nature. Submit your results on the RSPB website before 23rd January.
